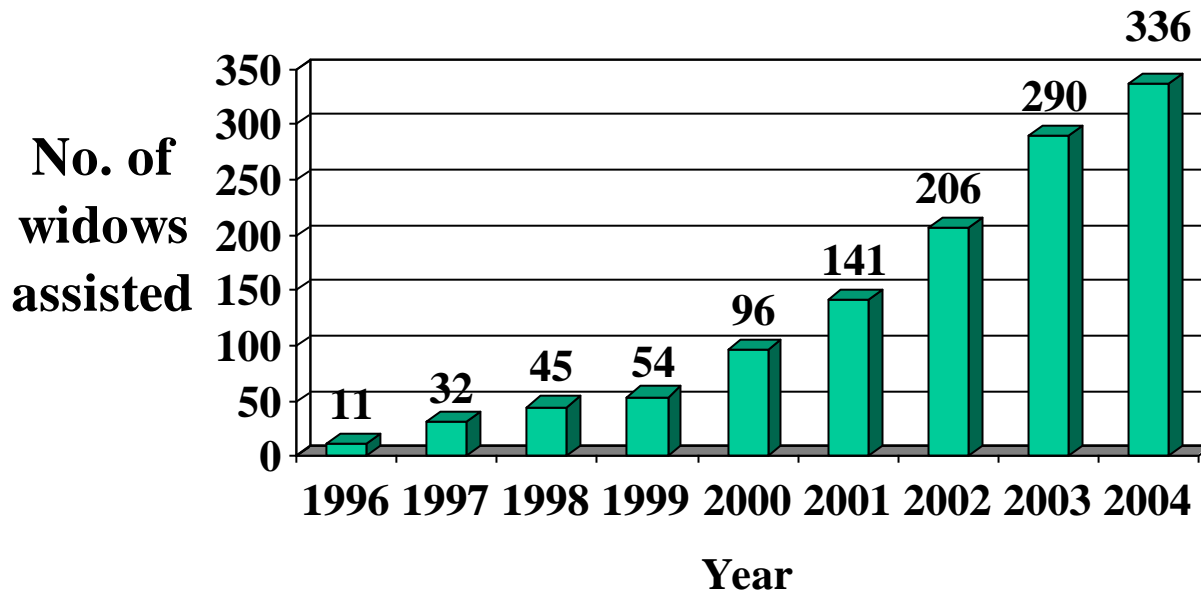
WELCOME

- developed a base and ongoing allocation table

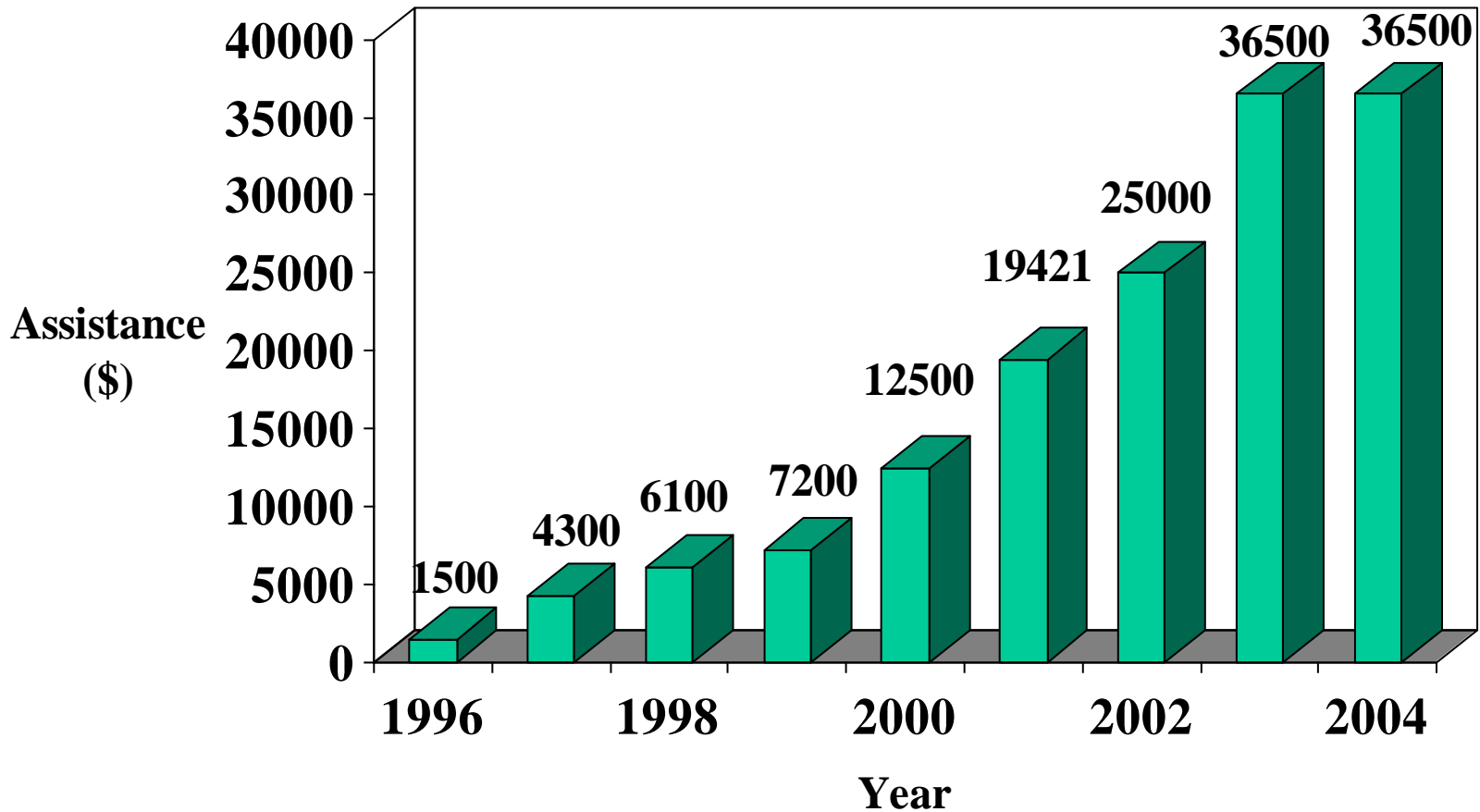
- prepared a CD containing details of schools and widows/children supported

CWEF is an incorporated, charitable, tax-exempt, nonprofit organization. CWEF's objective is to assist families in need with the education of their children. This charity was conceived and founded by five residents of Windsor and Essex County. CWEF currently has three chapters.

CWEF – Indian Chapter

The primary goal of the Indian Chapter is to enable the children of impoverished widows in India to stay in school. Without your help through organizations such as CWEF, many of these children would be unable to attend school, as they would have to work for their survival. CWEF gives an average annual assistance of \$132 per child. This is equivalent to the amount that a child might earn through child labour in one year. **Therefore, each donation of \$132 allows a child in India freedom from child labour and the opportunity to continue their education for one more year.** CWEF is currently (as of 2004) providing assistance to 360 children in India. **There are many more waiting to be helped.**

CWEF – Kenyan Chapter

The primary goal of the Kenyan Chapter is to enable children who have been affected by HIV to continue their education. CWEF will help children who have lost their parents to AIDS, children who have HIV infected parents and children who are themselves infected with HIV.

CWEF – Canadian Chapter

The Canadian Chapter is currently under development.
