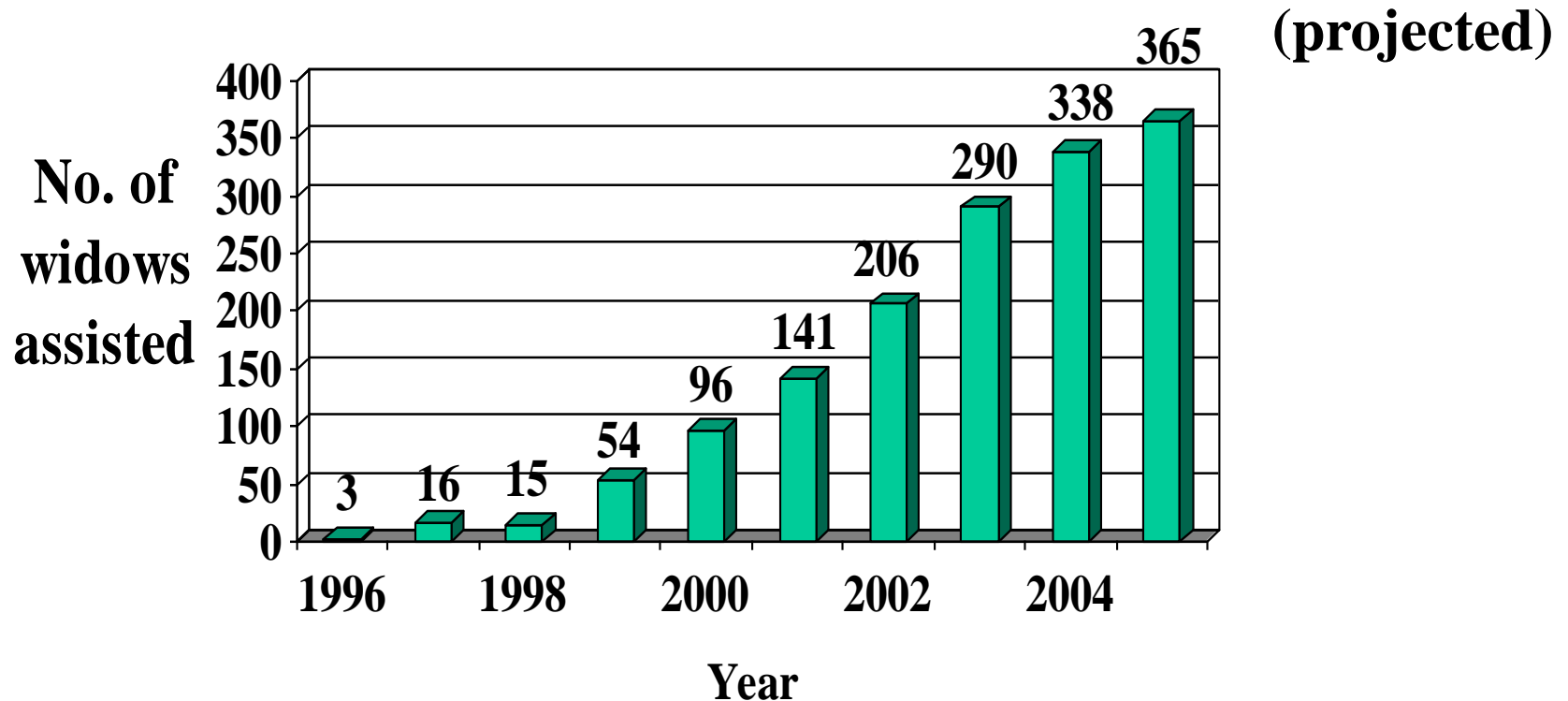

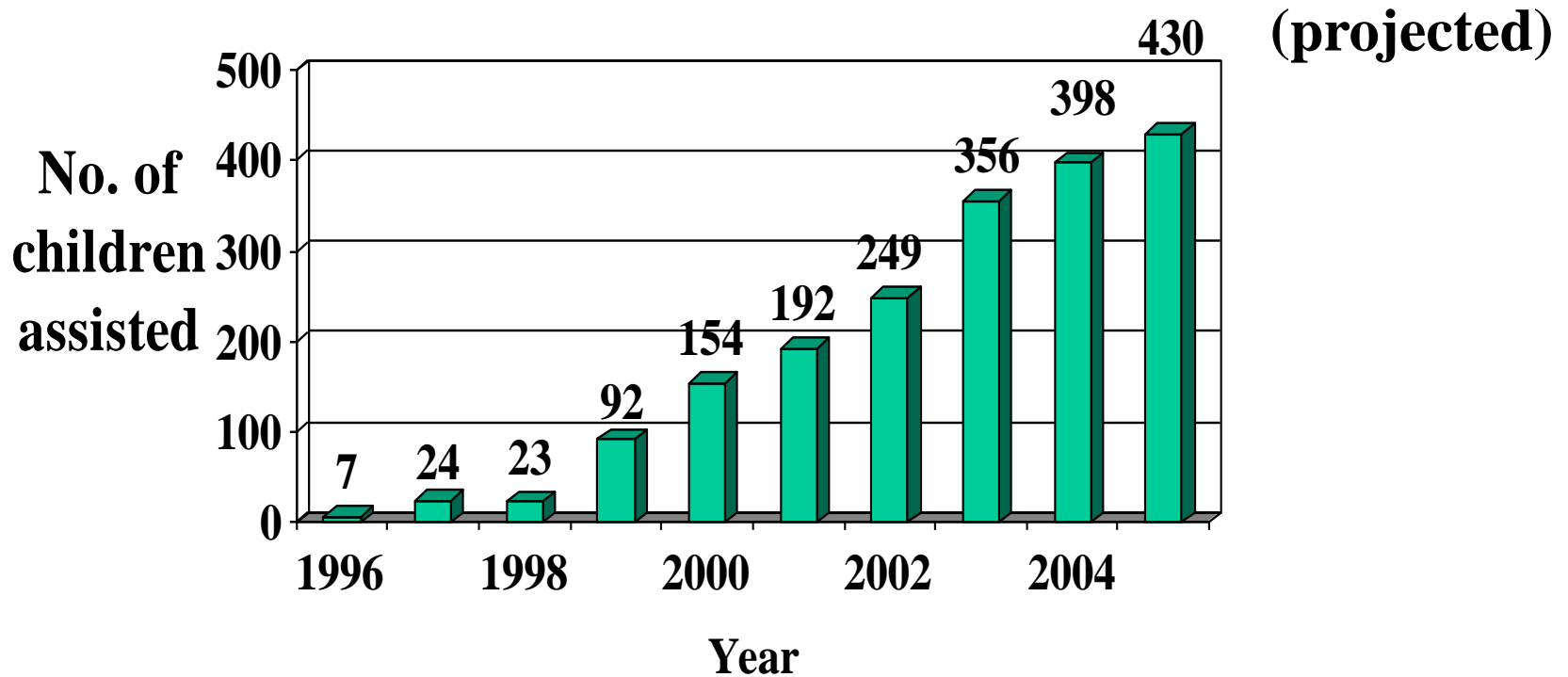

INDIAN CHAPTER GROWTH – Widows Assisted

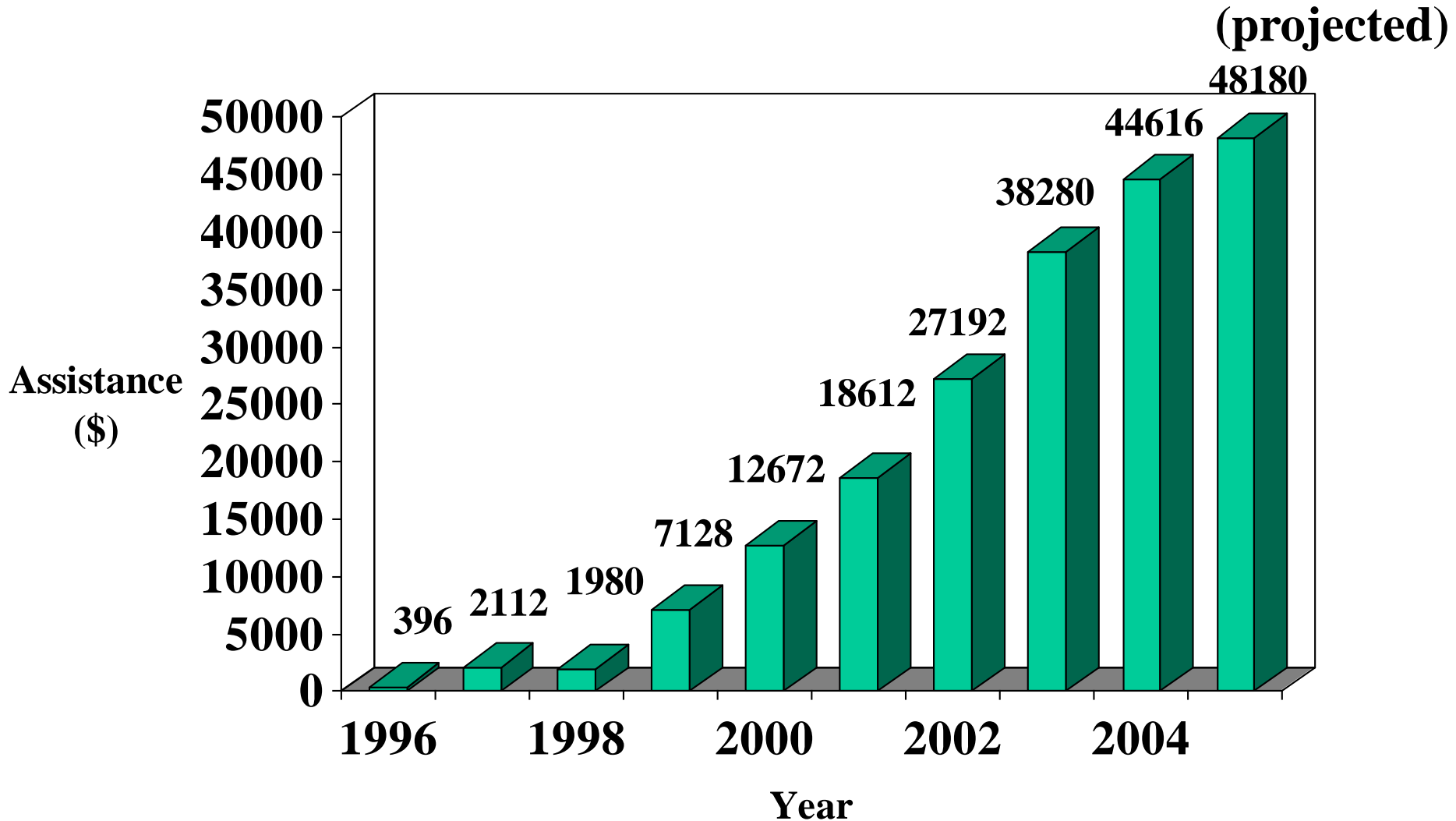


INDIAN CHAPTER GROWTH – Children Assisted
