### Background of Murungaru Primary School

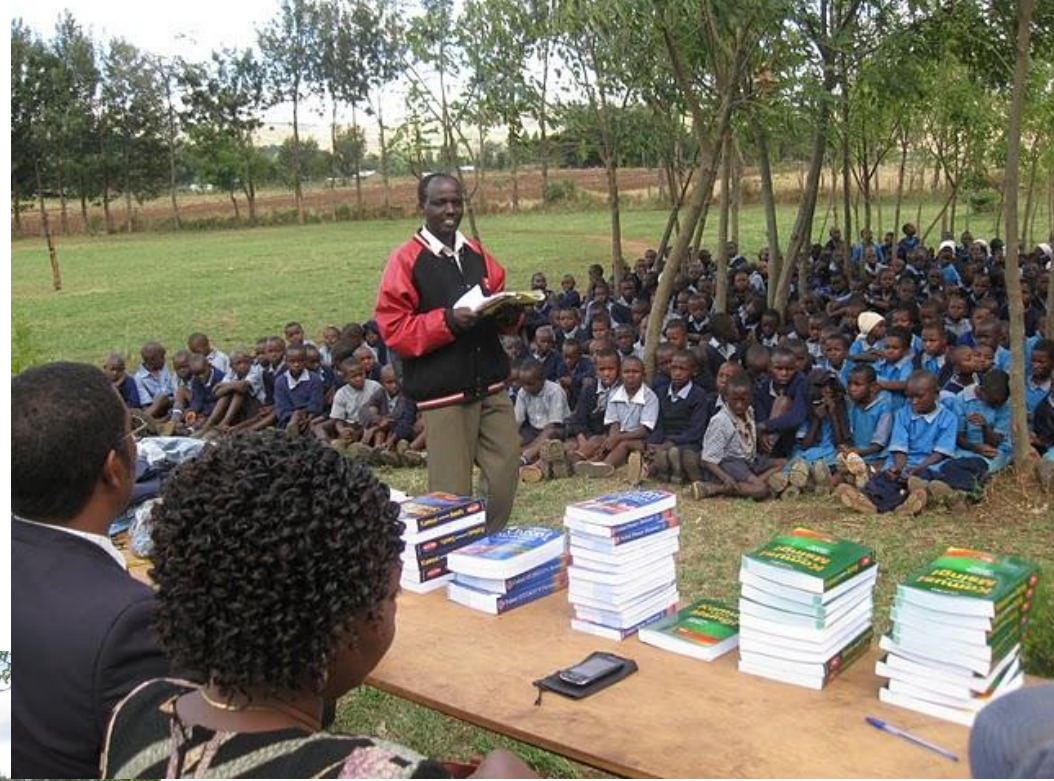
- MPS has a student population of 1200 students and 31 teachers

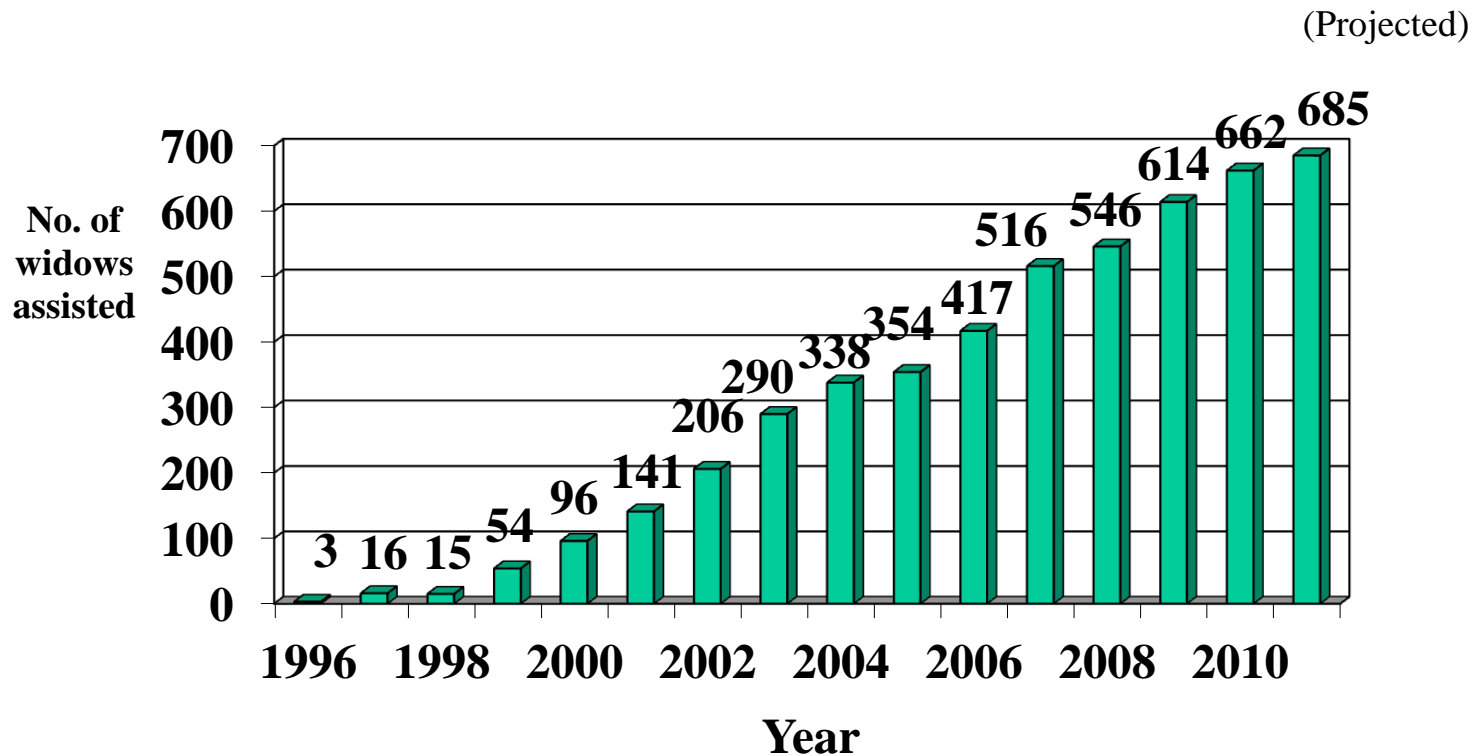

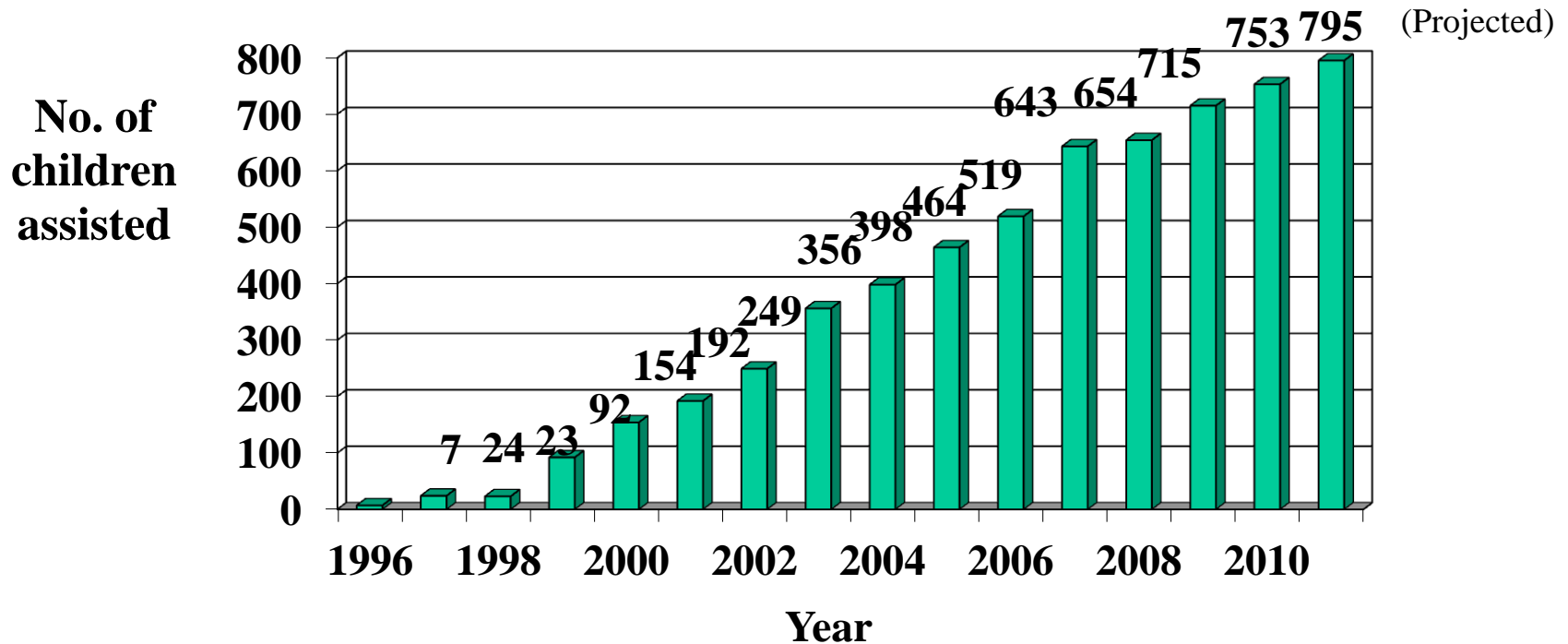
## **The academic year 2011-2012**

# INDIAN CHAPTER GROWTH – Widows Assisted

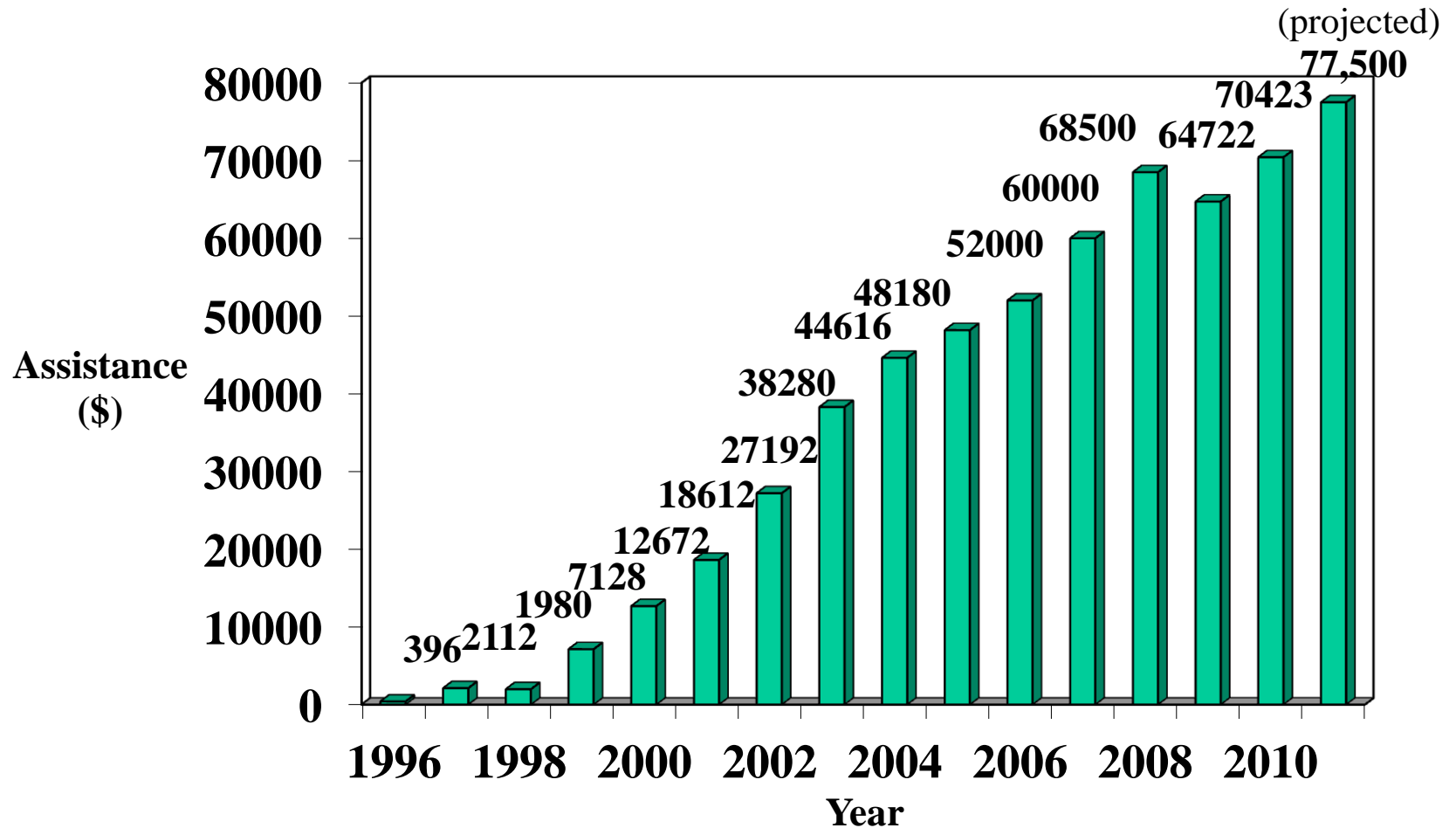


# INDIAN CHAPTER GROWTH – Children Assisted

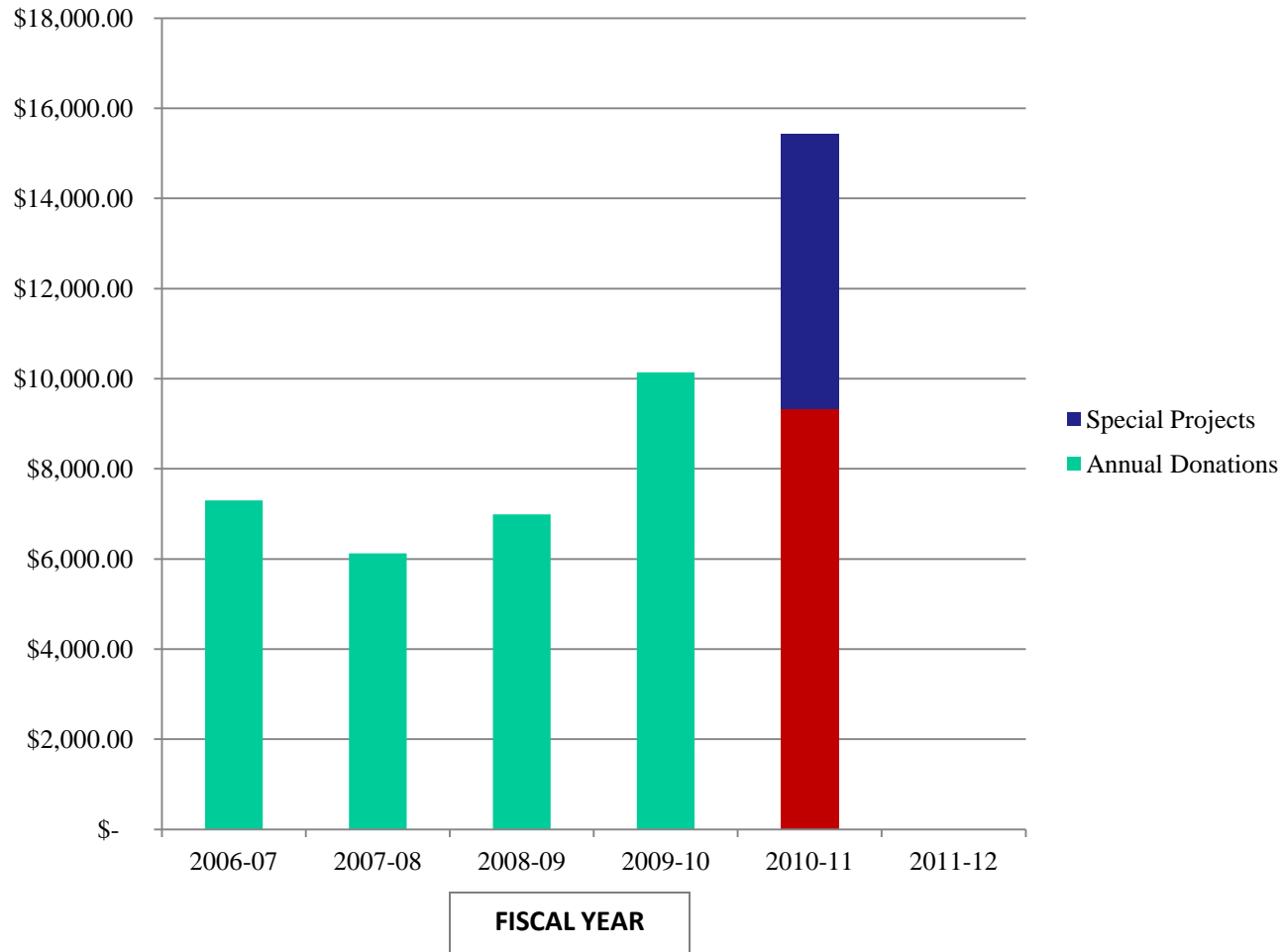

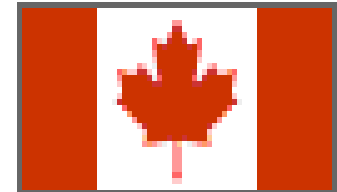
